CALL TO ORDER – President Tammy Lichter called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

APPROVE ACTING BOARD CLERK-MOTION — A motion was made by Jeanna
Wellbrock to accept Michelle Geist as Acting Board Clerk for the December 10, 2020 Special
Board of Education Meeting. Motion was seconded by Jackie Schmidt. Motion carried 7-0.

WELCOME GUESTS — Tammy Lichter welcomed Luke Johnson and Dan Rogers as guests to this meeting.

<u>APPROVE AGENDA-MOTION</u> – A motion was made by Ryan Mauch to accept the agenda as presented, seconded by Jeanna Wellbrock. Motion carried 7-0.

<u>DISCUSSION ON ATTENDANCE AT HOME BASKETBALL GAMES</u>—Mr. Dronberger discussed the KSHSAA ruling on November 24th, 2020 which would allow basketball games to be played, but no one (including parents) could attend those games. Another meeting was held

by the KSHAA on Tuesday, December 8, 2020 to appeal the decision on November 24th. It was recommended at that meeting that up to 2 parents/guardians could attend the basketball games as long social distancing could be accommodated. Individual school boards and/or County Health offices could weigh in on making that decision for each individual school.

Mr. Dronberger reported that our gym has been measured out and the home side could safely hold 56 people. Visitor side could hold 42 people (considering 6 feet for social distancing). Each gym that we attend would have their own rules depending on the County Health Office and the size of their gym as to how many parent/guardians could attend the away games. After much discussion, it was decided that we would allow two parents/guardians per participant(s) family to be allowed to attend Victoria basketball games. Tickets will be collected upon entry and signatures will be required. We will NOT be offering a concession stand. All spectators will be required to wear face coverings. To keep within our space limitations, we will encourage parents to come to their child's game only. All home games will be streamed on NFHS network. The band will be playing at the HS games. Band member only parents will not be attending the games because of space restrictions. If there is interest, Mr. Johnson has offered to set up a private Facebook page so those band parents can see their children participate between games and at half time in the band.

<u>MOTION</u> – A motion was made by Jeanna Wellbrock to allow only two parents/guardians per student family unit to attend home basketball games, seconded by Ryan Mauch. A vote was taken and passed 7-0.

MOTION TO ADJOURN MEETING - MOTION — A motion was made by Jeanna Wellbrock to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jackie Schmidt. Motion carried 7-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 P.M.
