Ongoing Mitigation Measures from Least to Most Restrictive

- Sanitization
- Hand Washing
- Distancing When Possible
- Close monitoring for symptoms
 - Do not send your child to school if they are sick.
 - Outbreak in any cohort and the cohort will quarantine as determined by Ellis Co. Health Dept./ CDC/ KDHE Guidelines.
- Based upon current active cases
- Levels will be set at a two week
 minimum

Follow CDC/ KDHE Guidelines

More than 20 active cases per building

Follow CDC guidelines as applicable.

Return to school no less than 5 days and fever free for no less than 24 hours- or whichever is longer (unless physician's instructions differ).

16 to 20 current active cases per building

Return to school when fever free and free of symptoms for no less than 24 hours, per physician's instructions.

Follow physician's recommendation and CDC/KDHE Guidelines.

Return with physician's approval per note.

11 to 15 current active cases per building

Follow physician's recommendation and CDC/KDHE Guidelines.

<u>General Recommendations</u>: A child diagnosed with COVID must follow the instructions of the most recent treatment protocol and advice of their physician and the CDC/KDHE Guidelines.
