President Matt Orr called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

APPROVE AGENDA-MOTION – A motion was made by Jake Hunter to accept the agenda as presented, seconded by Brenton Hoffman. Motion carried 6-0.

OPEN FORUM – There were no comments from visitors.

PRINCIPAL REPORTS -- Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Deutscher recognized various staff members and reported on their respective buildings. Mrs. Deutscher also reported on the 24-25 state assessments.

SUPERINTENT REPORT – Mr. Perkins reported that the new bleachers have been installed at the elementary and thanked all who helped take out the old ones. He gave an update on the 2025-26 student count, along with the past 2 years. He also updated the Board on the KSHSAA counts. VICTORIA RECREATION – Sean Rodger shared information with the Board in regard to putting a pickle ball court on school property and also resurfacing the outside basketball court.

MOTION – A motion was made by Brenton Hoffman to allow the recreation commission to resurface the outdoor basketball court and to allow them to put a pickleball court on school property pending location, seconded by Terry Dinkel. Motion carried 6-0.
